The Bethlehem Fair welcomes your display to be housed in our craft building. Tables will be assigned by a drawing. Assigned numbers will be posted in the Grange section.

1. Ten front feet of exhibit space, approximately three feet in width, will be given each Grange for their display. Displays may be arranged **Thursday afternoon or night starting at 1 PM.**
2. At least ten members of each Subordinate Grange are asked to contribute time or materials to the display. Each competing Grange shall present, in their display, a Grange theme of their own choosing. Judging is based on originality 20 points; quality 20 points; appearance 20 points; and theme and manner of presentation 40 points.
3. Names of Granges are not to appear on the displays until after judging has been completed, at which time the Fair will furnish cards bearing the name of the Grange for that purpose. Granges will not be required to furnish a list of items included in the display, but the display should include a well rounded variety of dairy, vegetables, floral and handy works of the Grange.
4. Committees planning to use crepe paper are warned that this must be flameproof to meet fire inspection.
5. The right of sale to the public of items included in the display will be given each Grange, but items sold must not be removed until 5:30 PM on Sunday.
6. Five guest tickets will be provided to the committee of each Grange entering a display.
