DEPARTMENT RULES

1. Selling Privileges will not be provided. Exhibits must remain until **5:30 PM** on Sunday.
2. Entries not removed by 6:30 PM Sunday, will become the property of the Fair and distributed to a local soup kitchen.
3. All entries must be in Ziploc type bags and on plate. Entry tags must be securely fastened to the plates. Frosted cakes need not be covered. Pie or Cake carriers are not allowed.
4. Any entry found to be made of a mix of any kind will be disqualified.
