WHO MAY ENTER: All residents of Connecticut. All exhibitors are expected to man the Christmas Tree Booth for several hours during the Fair.

ENTRY BLANKS: General – in the back of the premium book. Contact Superintendent to have a poster (describing your tree and your farm) made up for your entry.

ENTRY TAGS: Must be securely attached to exhibit. See general rules.

DELIVER EXHIBIT: To the South end of the Fairgrounds across from Mother Goose Building,

Thursday from 3 to 6 PM. All exhibitors are asked, if possible, to please help set up their trees when they deliver them. The Trees will be judged Friday afternoon. After judging, the posters will be put up next to each entry.

ENTRY FEES: Exhibitors must include \$7.00 (per exhibitor) entry fee. This entitles them to admission to the Fair on all three days.

RULES

1. Exhibitors can submit up to 3 trees, one tree in each class, and up to two wreaths (1 plain and 1 decorated).
2. Exhibit must remain until 5:30 PM Sunday. All exhibitors are expected to pickup their trees at 5:30 PM.

CHRISTMAS TREES

Must be fresh cut and not to exceed 7 feet in height. **This will be strictly enforced.** Trees will be judged by public opinion survey.
